

### **World Seed Program-2009 Seed Distribution**

In 2009 the World Seed Program shipped over 140 kilograms of agroforestry tree seeds (which equates to over 4 million seeds), to local non-profit organizations working in reforestation and agroforestry in the following countries: Haiti, Guatemala, Afghanistan, Cameroon, DR Congo, Nigeria, Tanzania, Sierra Leone, Uganda and Benin. Funds were also transferred to two organizations in Kenya to purchase seeds locally since phytosanitary restrictions make it very hard to send seeds to this country.
